

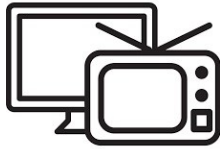

Recycle these Electronics & Small Appliances

Computers, Components & TVs:

Cables, Cell Phones, Copiers, Fax Machines, Flat Screens, Keyboards, Laptops, Monitors, Printers, Scanners, Telephones, TVs

Home Electronics:

DVD Players, Electronic Games, Pagers, Radios, Stereos & Speakers, VCRs

Small Appliances:

Irons, Microwave Ovens, Toasters, Vacuum Cleaners

Rechargeable Batteries:

Standard Rechargeable Batteries, plus: "Button" Cells, Hearing Aid Batteries, NiCad, NiMH

Fluorescent Bulbs:

4-foot, 2-foot, U-shape, round; **limit 6 bulbs, unbroken**

Paper Shredding for Confidential Papers

You can watch your confidential papers as they're shredded.

We cannot shred:

3-ring binders, "Pendaflex" hanging folders, fastened documents, CDs, hardcover books.

Limit:

5 boxes, residential only.
No businesses or institutions accepted.

Don't bring: **smoke detectors** – put in your regular trash (limit one per pickup)
regular batteries – put in your regular trash (they no longer contain mercury)
CFL (twist) bulbs – take to a Home Depot for proper recycling
