

ORDINANCE No. 31-2007

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON
AMENDING CHAPTER 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS,
ARTICLE 1 GENERAL PENALTY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey that the following sections of the Code of the Township of Livingston shall be revised as follows:


Italicized bold language is added, [deleted language is in bracket]

Section 1. §1-7 General Penalty.

A. Whenever [no specific] *the* penalty [is] provided *for in any section* of the Code of the Township or in any other ordinance of the Township for the punishment of an act which is prohibited or which is declared to be unlawful or an offense or for the non performance of an act which is required to be done *is a fine not to exceed \$500.00, that amount shall be amended to \$2,000.00*, so that the violation of any such provision shall be punished by a fine not to exceed *\$2,000.00*, or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days or both; or by a period of community service not exceeding 90 days, provided however that when the maximum penalty fixed by an applicable state statute is less, by force of said statute or by judicial construction, then any penalty fixed in the Code of the Township of Livingston, then limitations of such state statute shall be applicable.


Section 2. Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and twenty days from publication in accordance with the law.
