

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON  
AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 232 OF THE  
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey that the following sections of the Code of the Township of Livingston shall be revised as follows:

*Italicized bold language is added, [deleted language is in bracket]*

Section 1.

Chapter 232 Recycling is amended and revised as follows:

§232.1 Definitions

**Paper:**

1. *Mixed newspaper, magazines, junk mail, phonebook, paperback books, office paper, school paper, brown paper bags, car gated card board (broken down and bundled together) and chip board (cereal, pasta, cookie pizza and gift boxes etc)*
2. *Corrugated cardboard...shipping boxes, pizza boxes, and retail chipboard, containers, brown bags and paper wrapping paper (remove all styrofoam)*
3. *Mixed paper...all of the above mixed together*
4. *Items not accepted for recycling with paper items include burnt or sun burnt paper, wax coded car gated cardboard boxes, toy boxes with a plastic window or plastic strapping and Styrofoam in any form.*

**Commingled:**

1. *Aluminum food, soda and beer containers, pet food cans, etc.*
2. *Ferrous cans-tin/steel soup, food, coffee cans.*
3. *Glass food and beverage containers, clear and brown and green only.*
4. *Plastic containers with a symbol #1 through #7-plastic soda or beverage bottles milk and water jugs, condiment bottles and jars, cooking oil bottles, yogurt containers, grocery store produce bags, plastic food wrap, shampoo bottles, bleach bottles, household detergent bottles and Styrofoam.*
5. *Items not accepted for recycling with commingled items include mirrors, window or auto glass, light bulbs, ceramics, any paper products, wire and "coat" hangers (wire of any kind) electrical equipment, dishes, pots, appliances.*


§232.3 Mandatory separation  
Recyclable products.


Each resident must separate [glass and aluminum products] *paper and commingled items as defined in Section 232.1* from other solid waste generated at a residential premises.


Section 3. Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and twenty days from publication in accordance with the law.
