

ORDINANCE No. 35-2007

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON  
AMENDING CHAPTER 29 PARKING AND TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS OF THE  
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey that the following sections of the Code of the Township of Livingston shall be revised as follows:

Section 1.

§29.10 Stopping or standing prohibited all times.


No person shall stop or stand a vehicle at anytime upon any of the described streets, portions of street to a designated area;


<u>Street</u>	<u>Sides</u>	<u>Location</u>
<i>Microlab Road</i>	<i>West</i>	<i>From the intersection with state highway Route 10 to appoint 50 feet past the exit driveway from the drive up facility.</i>


Section 2. Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and twenty days from publication in accordance with the law.
