

ORDINANCE No. 4-2009

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 316 "WATER"
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON

WHEREAS, due to construction of additions and demolition, contractors are removing and discarding water meter radio reading devices attached to these structures, causing the Township to incur a cost for the installation of a new meter and or equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council believes it is appropriate for the Township to recoup its expenses for the installation of a new meter by charging a fee for the replacement of all water meters and equipment.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, the Township of Livingston in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. §316-2 Installation of meter;




B. The meter shall be set at a location in the Building where it is easily accessible to the employees of the Township for reading, inspection and testing. No meter shall be installed in an external pit unless approved by the Superintendent-Water Engineer. The meter, remote wiring and outside reading terminal shall be protected from freezing and other damage. Failure to provide reasonable care for the maintenance of the meter, wiring and outside reading terminal shall be cause to repair replacement of said component at the expense of the property owner. *Each property owner shall also pay a fee of \$100 for the labor of replacement of all water meters and equipment.*


Section 2. Except as hereby amended the General Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and twenty (20) days from publication and in accordance with the law.
