

**AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY
TEMPORARY BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS**


WHEREAS, an emergent condition has arisen in that the Township is expected to enter into contracts, commitments or payments prior to the adoption of the 2009 Municipal Budget and adequate provision has not been made in the 2009 Temporary Budget for the aforesaid purposes; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of emergency temporary appropriations for said purposes; and,


WHEREAS, the total temporary emergency appropriations adopted in the year 2009 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 96, P.L. 1951 (N.J.S. 40A:4-20) including this resolution total \$7,019,056.27 for the Current Fund, \$182,200.00 for the Water Utility Fund, \$171,450.00 for the Sewer Utility Fund, and \$34,500 for the Swimming Pool Utility Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey, (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with the provision of N.J.S. 40A:4-20:


1. Emergency appropriations be and the same are hereby made in the amount of \$932,100.00 for the Current Fund, \$53,200.00 for the Water Utility Fund, \$109,200.00 for the Sewer Utility Fund, and \$34,500.00 for the Swimming Pool Utility Fund as listed on the following pages;
2. Said temporary emergency appropriations will be provided for in the 2009 Municipal Budget;
3. That one certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Director, Division of Local Government Services.
