Activities: Participants will help prepare for the future Dog Park. The volunteers distribute wood chips in wooded areas of the proposed dog park. The volunteers will be supervised by members of the Friends of Livingston Dog Parks.

Dress: Please wear appropriate clothing for working outdoors – long pants, long sleeves, layered clothing for weather, **hiking or waterproof work boots**, socks, hat (optional).

What to bring: Bottled water, lunch, work gloves (preferably leather), insect repellent, sun screen, leaf rakes, pitch forks, loppers, Wheelbarrows and hard tine rakes.

DIRECTIONS TO EAST HILLS PARK, LIVINGSTON

VIA ROUTE 78

Heading east: after passing Summit, stay right following signs for "local 24/ 124" and NOT express toward the airport. Continue about half a mile to the Millburn exit on the left. Blend into the traffic, working your way gradually to the right lane over a 2-mile ride. Exit at 7-C " The Mall at Short Hills, JFK, Livingston, RT.280". After the first driveway, make a quick right, again following the small Exit 7-C sign, that repeats "JFK, Livingston, The Caldwells, & RT. 280. Continue about 3 miles into town, following directions for, "Via JFK pkwy".

VIA JFK:

Pass the Short Hills Mall, traveling north on JFK Pkwy. Continue through 2 traffic lights: So. Orange Ave., Hobart Gap Rd. At the 3rd light turn Right onto Northfield Ave./Rd. Go to the next traffic light and make a left onto East Cedar St. The park will be about a ½ mile on right after a new residential housing development.

VIA NJ TPKE:

To exit 15W. Follow signs for RT. 280 West. Stay to the left only as you enter leave Newark and enter East Orange, following the RT. 280 West signs. Follow directions for, "Via Route 280"

VIA GARDEN STATE PKWY:

To exit 145. Follow directions for, "Via Route 280"

VIA ROUTE 80 IF YOU ARE WEST OF LIVINGSTON:

RT. 80 East to RT. 280 East. Follow directions for, "Via Route 280"

VIA ROUTE 280: Continue on 280 to Exit 6A "Laurel Ave Exit" coming from the East or Exit 6 Laurel Ave South coming from the West. Bear right as you exit. Bear slightly left, as Laurel Ave becomes Shrewsbury Dr. Go straight at the light at Mt Pleasant Ave (Rte 10). Continue about 1 mile. After you pass N. Baums Ct. on the right, the entrance to East Hills Park will be the first driveway on the left.

VIA ROUTE 287:

RT.287 to Rt.10 east toward Whippany and East Hanover. Follow directions for "Via Route 10"

VIA ROUTE 10 IF YOU ARE WEST OF LIVINGSTON:

RT. 10 east to Livingston traffic circle, continue halfway around the circle. Continue straight on Rt. 10 after the circle go about 2 miles to the 6th light, Shrewsbury Dr. turn right. Continue about 1 mile you will pass N Baums Ct on the right, the entrance to East Hills Park will be the first driveway on the left.
