LIVINGSTON SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA WILL PRESENT FIRST CONCERT OF SEASON ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 14

The Livingston Symphony Orchestra (LSO) will inaugurate its 2004-2005 season on Sunday, November 14, with a concert entitled “Grandeur and Romance.” Under the direction of Istvan Jaray, the orchestra will perform the Overture to *Rienzi* by Richard Wagner, *Concerto for Violin and Orchestra, No. 1, G Minor*, by Max Bruch and *Symphony in D Minor* by César Franck. The concert will take place at 7:30 p.m. at Livingston High School, 30 Robert Harp Drive (off of South Livingston Avenue, between Northfield and South Orange Avenues) in Livingston. The soloist for the Bruch Concerto will be Byung-Kook Kwak, whose career as an international performing artist began at the age of 7 when he made his orchestral debut with the Seoul Philharmonic.

During its current season the LSO will present three additional events: a popular young people’s concert on Sunday, February 6; a spring concert on Saturday, April 2, featuring the winner of the Symphony’s young artists’ concerto competition; and a family concert, “A Night at the Opera,” on Saturday, May 21.
