

ORDINANCE NO. 26-2006

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 29 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON TO ADD A NEW ARTICLE XVI COMMUTER PARKING FACILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that the following sections of the Code of the Township of Livingston shall be revised as follows:

Italicized bold language is added

Section 1 *Chapter 29 Article XVI Commuter Parking Facilities*

§29-53 Purpose: The purpose of this Article is to regulate parking in the Township's designated commuter parking facilities.

§29-54 Designated Parking Spaces

- (1) All drivers having a valid commuter parking permit shall only park within the marked spaces in the North end of the parking lot designated for commuter parking.*
- (2) Drivers shall not park in any location which shall block any other car or prevent emergency vehicles unencumbered access throughout the parking lot.*

§29-55 Commuter shall only park in the designated space between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and midnight – Monday through Thursday, and 6:00 a.m. through 8:00 p.m. on Fridays.

§29-56 Overnight Parking: No one shall be permitted to park overnight in the commuter parking lot.

§29-57 Removal


- (1) Any vehicle may be subject to removal if it is parked overnight in a commuter lot or when the lot is snow covered so as to hinder the ability to plow the lot.*
- (2) Removal can be authorized by any municipal law enforcement officer.*
- (3) The owner of the vehicle shall pay the reasonable cost of removal and storage before regaining possession of the vehicle.*


§29-58 Enforcement: Municipal law enforcement officers shall enforce the regulations as set forth in this Article XVI.


§29-59 Violations and penalties: Any person who violates any provision of this Article shall be subject to the penalties as set forth in Chapter I-7 General Penalties of the Code of the Township of Livingston.

Section 2 Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3 This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
