

ORDINANCE NO. 23__-2005

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 210
PARKS & RECREATION OF THE GENERAL CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON
ADDING A NEW SECTION – “LITTLE LEAGUE FIELDS”**

WHEREAS, the National and American Little Leagues of Livingston have created Little League baseball fields for the playing of baseball by Little League teams; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Township Council that individuals not associated with the Little League organizations are accessing these fields and by hitting baseballs out of the confines of the fields are causing damage to the surrounding homes and properties and endangering the welfare of the individuals living around the baseball fields.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston and County of Essex, State of New Jersey that Article III Little League Fields shall be added to Chapter 210 Parks & Recreation.

Section 1 (Prohibited Acts.) All unauthorized activities are hereby prohibited on the grounds of the American and National Little League fields. Unauthorized use of these little league baseball fields will subject the individuals to fines. A sign notifying the public of these restrictions will be placed at each facility.


Section 2. Violations and Penalties. Any person who violates this Article shall, upon conviction, therefore be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day, during or at which a violation occurs.

Section 3. Except as hereby amended the General Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.


