

ORDINANCE NO. 33, 2005

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 29 BY ADDING A NEW ARTICLE XVI
“ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING” TO THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON
TO AMEND PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON A PORTION OF VIRGINIA AVENUE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The following new article XVI Alternate Side Parking shall be added to Chapter 29 of the Code of the Township of Livingston:

New language is bold and italicized, deleted language is bracketed

29-53 Alternate Side Parking – No person shall park a vehicle on the following street except as specified below. Saturday, Sunday and public holidays excluded

| <u>Street</u> | <u>Side</u> | <u>Days</u> | <u>Location</u> |
|------------------------|-------------|---------------------------|---|
| <i>Virginia Avenue</i> | <i>West</i> | <i>even calendar days</i> | <i>308 ft from the southern curb line Of W. Mt. Pleasant Avenue to Wilson Terrace</i> |
| <i>Virginia Avenue</i> | <i>East</i> | <i>odd calendar days</i> | <i>From the southern curb line of W. Mt. Pleasant Avenue to Wilson Terrace</i> |

Section 2. The following is deleted from §29-11 parking limited to two hours

| <u>Street</u> | <u>Sides</u> | <u>Location</u> |
|-----------------|--------------|---|
| Virginia Avenue | both | From the southerly curb line Of W. Mt. Pleasant Avenue (State Highway Rt. 10) to a point 250 south thereafter] |

Section 3. Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
