They will be used to promote open space within the community, and will be displayed at the community center, town hall, town website and various public places throughout the community.

The LOSC will award prizes in two age categories: students ages 18 and under and adult amateur photographers. The Livingston Camera Club will be judging the photos that best showcase our "Outdoor Treasures". Please help us showcase the results of the great work of many people throughout the Township.

The Rules:

All photos must be taken within the township borders.

All applicants must be Livingston residents.

Each applicant may submit up to 3 photos.

All submissions must be 8"x10" unmounted, or mounted (on a mat board no larger than 16" x 20"), and must definitely NOT BE FRAMED.

Include with each photo two 3x5 index cards:

On the one list your name, age group, address, phone number and email address.

On the second card include your name, location and date of photo. This second card will be used when displaying the photo.

Include a unique identifier on both index cards and the photo so they can be properly matched.
