

The Township of Livingston will be conducting an entrance examination for police officers. Interested applicants can obtain an application at the Livingston Police Headquarters 333 S Livingston Ave Livingston NJ 07039, beginning on Thursday April 16, 2009 at 12 noon through Tuesday May 5, 12 noon. Only the first two hundred (200) applications returned with the required fee of \$75.00 (check or money order) will be accepted and given the test booklet for the written examination.

In order for a candidate to be considered for employment as a full time police officer, he/she must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. A citizen of the United States.
2. Of mental and bodily health sufficient to satisfy the Board of Trustees of the Police and Firemen's Retirement System of New Jersey that he/she would be eligible for membership in the retirement system.
3. Able to read, write and speak the English language well and intelligently.
4. Of good moral character and free from conviction of any crime constituting an indictable offense or any crime or offense involving moral turpitude.
5. Able to pass such written, oral, physical and psychological examinations as may be approved by the Township and meet essential job performance requirements.
6. (a.) Must hold an Associates Degree

***or***

(b.) Completed sixty (60) college credits from an accredited post secondary college.

***or***

(c.) Two (2) years of active military service with an honorable discharge.

7. The holder of a valid New Jersey driver's license at time of appointment.
8. Otherwise meets all the requirements of N.J.S. 40A:14-122 to N.J.S. 40A:14-127.
