

SUMMER 2009 POOL INFO FROM THE LIVINGSTON, NJ RECREATION DEPARTMENT

New for this coming pool season, membership photo ID badges will be digital and will have a bar code that will be scanned upon entrance to the pool. Each member, regardless of age, will need a badge, and those three years of age by the end of 2009 and older will need to have a picture taken even if they already have a photo ID badge from previous years. To hasten the process, you may stop at the recreation office, 204 Hillside Avenue, any time from now on, during operating hours, to have your photo taken, even if you are not completing the membership process at that time. We will bank your photo and complete the photo pass production upon submission of your application and payment which can then be done by mail with the appropriate application form, or in person.

Processed membership passes will need to be picked up in person at the Recreation Office. Application forms are available online and at the Recreation Office and will be included in the Spring Summer Program Guide mailed to all residents. In subsequent years, once you have the new digital photo membership pass, the process will be even simpler. Validating a membership may be accomplished upon submission of a current application and payment by mail, without having to visit the recreation office, unless a new photo needs to be taken.

In spite of new pool resurfacing, new benches, picnic tables, deck chairs and other amenities, there will be no membership fee increase for the 2009. As in the past, there will be a three-tier fee schedule: early, discount and regular. To meet discount deadlines, application forms and payment must be processed in person at the recreation department office or post marked by the deadline date. Photos may be taken at any time; however, entry to the pool will require a completed new photo pool pass.

The early fees, available through March 20, will be \$225 for a family and \$110 for an individual. A family of two (2) may register as two (2) individuals, each on a separate registration form, on or before March 20 to save money. A senior couple membership may be obtained if one of the partners is at least 62 years of age, and will cost \$120. The fee for a senior individual membership is \$85.

Those completing the early registration process of submitting the application with all family members and payment will receive one (1) free guest badge per membership.

The discount fee will be in effect from March 21 through May 1. Family discount rates will be \$250; individuals will pay \$120; and seniors will pay \$90 for individuals and \$135 for a senior couple.

Regular rates will be applicable after May 1 and will be as follows: \$295 for a family; \$145 for an individual; \$100 for an individual senior; and \$150 for a senior couple.

Completed membership passes are to be picked up at the Recreation Department office, 204 Hillside Avenue, during regular office hours: Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturdays 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 pm September through June.
