Twp of Livingston Curbside Residential Garbage Collection Starts – July 1st

The Township of Livingston reminds our residents, that starting on Thursday, July 1, 2010, residential garbage pickup at their homes will change. The current rear yard collection of solid waste in containers from behind houses ends on June 30th and is now a curbside collection program.

The Township is currently out to bid for a contract for the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Solid Waste, which begins Wednesday, September 1, 2010 and will include an optional service for continuing rear yard pick-up for residents. The first option is for the rear yard pick-up of one garbage container per collection day and the second option is for the rear yard pick-up of a maximum of three garbage containers per collection day. Residents choosing one of the rear yard pick-up options will be billed directly by the solid waste collector for the difference in cost between curbside collection and rear yard pick-up.

Beginning with Thursday's regular pickup (July 1st), Township residents will now place their solid waste containers at curbside on their regularly scheduled collection day. Household garbage should be placed in suitable rigid material, watertight containers with tight-fitting covers and are not to be placed at the curb for collection along any street earlier than 12:00 noon on the day immediately before their regularly scheduled pickup. Full garbage containers can not weigh more than 50 lbs each.
