Twp of Livingston Curbside Residential Solid Waste Collection Begins – July 1st

The Township of Livingston reminds our residents, that beginning with the Thursday, July 1, 2010 regular neighborhood collections, the pickup of garbage from containers at their homes will change. The current rear yard collection of solid waste in containers from behind residential structures will become a curbside collection program.

Residents should continue to follow the present Township of Livingston requirements for the handling of solid waste or garbage. Household garbage should be placed in suitable receptacles or containers made of rigid material, watertight and with tight-fitting covers. Containers or receptacles shall not be placed for collection along the curb of any street earlier than 12:00 noon on the day immediately before their regularly scheduled pickup or collection.

Beginning July 1st, Township residents will place their solid waste containers at curbside for pickup on their regularly scheduled collection day. The frequency of collection, types of materials collected, the limit of (3) 30 gallon containers per collection day will continue to be the same. Full garbage containers can not weigh more than 50 lbs each.
