Senior Transportation Volunteer Drivers - Provides bus service for senior citizens in the Township of Livingston

Sports Council - Encourages participation in sports and good sportsmanship

Technology Management Committee - Improves access to municipal government and services through information technology solutions.

Township Appearance Committee - Recommends and implements suggestions toward improving the town's' appearance.

Township Golf Tournament Committee - Plans and coordinates Township annual golf tournament.

Trails & Greenways Committee - Promotes safe, non-motorized travel, healthy lifestyles, and the protection of open space and greenways by proposing a system of local and regional trails.

Vision 20/20 Committee - Provides recommendations to Council on long-range goals for Township.

Zoning Board of Adjustment - Hears and decides applications to vary or modify the provisions of the zoning ordinance.

Advisory Committee on Senior Citizens - Studies, reports and issues recommendations on the needs of senior citizens in the Township.

Advisory Committee on Senior, Youth & Leisure Services

(formerly known as Advisory Committee on Recreation and Parks)

Advises Town Council on community recreation and leisure activities for the community.

Advisory Committee on Transportation - Provides recommendations to the Township Council to support and improve safety and mobility throughout the Township.

Advisory Health Committee - Studies Health needs of Township and provides reports and recommendations to Township Council.

Arts Council of Livingston - Coordinates and promotes cultural activities in the Township and encourages quality offerings in performing and visual arts in Livingston and its surrounding areas.

Auxiliary Police - Assists Police in tasks as assigned by the Chief of Police.

Bi-Partisan Advisory Committee on Committee Appointments - Receives and reviews applications and makes recommendations to the Township Council for appointments to Township Committees.

Camuso Collection Preservation Committee - Ensures proper preservation and arranges for public display of holiday decorations which had been donated to the Township by the Camuso family.

Citizens' Budget Advisory Committee - At the direction of the Township Council, reviews programs and services offered by the Township to determine their necessity, justification and cost effectiveness.

Committee for the Improvement of Playing Fields - Advises the Township Council and Board of Education as to improvements of Community Playing Fields.

Community Outreach Committee - Helps guide citizens unfamiliar with existing volunteer advisory committees and encourages citizens who have not been part of Township activities to get involved, perpetuating the outstanding volunteerism on which Livingston has prided itself.

Consumer Affairs Committee - Protects citizens from consumer fraud and provides consumer education.

Deer Management Committee - Researches and identifies available techniques for deer management and makes recommendations to the Township Council.

Emergency Planning Council - meets the needs of the community for an efficient and effective emergency preparedness action plan.

Fire Department - Safeguards lives and property of residents and visitors, through the delivery of emergency responses, fire safety education and fire prevention enforcement.

First Aid Squad - Provides emergency response to health emergencies for the residents, businesses and visitors of Livingston, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Fourth of July Celebration Committee - Plans, conducts and supervises the annual Independence Day observance and celebration.

Friends of Livingston Dog Parks - Monitors two fenced-in areas where dogs can socialize and exercise off-leash, legally, in a public park, under supervision of an adult.

Library Board of Trustees - Acts as the citizen governing body of the library.

Littell's Pond Skating Committee - Develops ice skating and ice hockey programs at Littell's Pond.

Living Green Team - Consisting of representatives from the Township's administration and committees, provides strategy and coordination for Livingston's environmental initiatives.

Livingston Bicentennial Committee - Creates and plans events to celebrate Livingston's Bicentennial Year in 2013.

Livingston Committee For Diversity - Encourages recognition of commonalities and appreciation of the racial, ethnic and cultural diversity that so richly enhances our community.

Livingston Environmental Commission (LEC) - Makes recommendations to the Township Council on issues relating to the protection, development and use of natural resources, including water resources and open space located within the township.

Livingston Municipal Alliance Committee (LMAC) - Works for prevention of substance abuse.

Livingston Open Space Trust Fund Committee - Offers recommendations about the purchase and preservation of open space and historic properties for conservation, recreation and preservation purposes.

Livingston Public Broadcasting Committee (LPBC) - Responsible for the Livingston community access television channels.

Livingston Public Broadcasting Executive Board - Determines policies and programming for Livingston's Public Access television stations, in consultation with LPBC.

Livingston Recycling and Reclamation Committee - Promotes and raises awareness of all types of recycling in Livingston.

Livingston Skate Park Committee - Plans, develops, and fund-raises for building the Township Skate Park.
