

**RESOLUTION of AMENDMENT

**WHEREAS**, the Board has previously adopted Memorializing Resolutions in the above captioned matter on October 7, 2014 and April 7, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, Allyson M. Kasetta, Esq., attorney for the Applicant, has provided an analysis, confirmed by Veena Sawant, Township Planner, that textual errors are in Paragraph G on page 3 and in Paragraph G on page 6 of the April 7, 2015 Memorializing Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that this is a matter as to which no notice of hearing is required;

**IT IS NOW HEREBY RESOLVED** in Open Public Conference Meeting as follows:

1. The Memorializing Resolution adopted in this matter on April 7 2015 is hereby amended now as of then by:

a. Deleting Paragraph G on page 3 and substituting therefor:

“G. Code Section 170-90.L.(1)(g) limits the gross area of all wall signage to 5% of the area of the main building elevation facing the street, whereas the proposed screen wall tower would bring the total gross area of such signs to 13.18%; resulting in a variance request.”


b. In Paragraph G on page 6, deleting “17.2%” and substituting therefor “13.18%”, deleting “the 15.26%” and substituting therefor “that”, and deleting “of 1.94%”.

2. These corrections are calculated as of April 7, 2015 by reference to the analysis and advice received by the Board.

3. All the remaining terms, provisions, findings and holdings of the aforesaid Memorializing Resolution are hereby continued in full force and effect.
