TAX SALE OF REAL ESTATE FOR UNPAID TAXES AND OTHER MUNICIPAL CHARGES

Public notice is hereby given that I, Vibha Desai, Tax Collector of the taxing district of the Township of Livingston, in the County of Essex, State of New Jersey will on October 27, 2022, hold an online Tax Sale, which will expose for taxes, and /or other municipal charges remain unpaid for the year 2022 and prior subject to N.J.S.A. 54:5 et seq. together with interest to such date and cost of sale and cost of mailing. Please visit <https://livingston.newjerseytaxsale.com> for a listing and registration. Properties for which there are no purchasers shall be struck off & sold to the Township of Livingston.

At any time before the sale payment of the amount due on any property with all interest and cost will be accepted, with payment in the form of cash, money order or certified check only.

Industrial properties may be subject to the Spill Compensation and Control Act (N.J.S.A.58:58:10-23.11 et seq), the Water Pollution Control Act (N.J.S.A.58:10A-1 et seq.) and the Industrial Site Recovery Act (N.J.S.A. 13:1K-6et seq).

In addition, the municipality is precluded from issuing a tax sale certificate to any perspective purchaser who is or may be in any way connected to prior owner or operator of this site.

In the event the owner is on active duty with the military the collector should be notified immediately.
